



## Recruitment for Two Consortium Volunteer Posts

**The Consortium seeks three individuals for one-year volunteer positions.**

*Note: University faculty members are encouraged to seek out appropriate doctoral students who may earn internship credit for assuming one of these positions.*

### **1. News Editor**

The News Editor will be responsible for developing and maintaining the Consortium Home Page News Column in consultation with the CPSV President and Webmaster. The News Column will be updated every two weeks with fresh information appearing every other Monday morning. The News Column content will include items such as: (a) media coverage of school violence-related events; (b) announcements of new prevention and intervention programs; (c) noteworthy new local, state, and federal initiatives; (d) legislative developments relating to school violence; (e) grants for school violence research and practice; (f) upcoming conferences, symposia, and workshops; and (g) major reports, key research articles of interest, and other news of interest to the school violence research and practice community at the local, state, and federal level. The news editor will be available for rapid posting of information in the event of a major national school violence related occurrence.

### **2. Features Editor**

The Features Editor will be responsible for developing and maintaining the Consortium Home Page Features Column in consultation with the CPSV President and Webmaster. The Features Column will be updated monthly. Two regular monthly features will be: (a) an interview with a leader in school violence prevention and (b) examination and discussion of a promising or proven school violence prevention and intervention program. The Features Editor will periodically develop other special features of interest to the school violence research and practice community at the local, state, and federal levels.
